Jessamine County Water District No. 1 (JCWD1) is committed to continually improving your water system and to providing the best service that we feasibly can to our customers at a reasonable monthly rate. As such, JCWD1 has acquired federal funding, in the form of a low interest long-term loan, to complete a project will replace and enlarge the existing water mains on Carolyn Lane and Vincewood Drive. This will replace existing 3" and 4" water main with 6" and 8" water main, which will allow us to install fire hydrants in both neighborhoods. In addition, the project will include the installation of new water meters that include the capability to be read remotely. The project is anticipated to cost approximately \$1,500,000.
